#### **Parking & Traffic Flow:**

Traffic flow for attendees will be directed to the southeast garages and parking lots along Ponce De Leon Boulevard utilizing the main entrances of Dickinson Drive, Merrick Drive, and Stanford drive for both egress & ingress.

Parking Utilization: estimated availability 3,000 spaces.



## Orange & Greentree Game - Parking Utilization (Attendees)

Traffic flow for attendees will be directed to the southeast garages and parking lots along Ponce De Leon Boulevard utilizing the main entrances of Dickinson Drive, Merrick Drive, and Stanford Drive for both egress & ingress. Coral Gables Police department will be staged at all major intersections to support traffic flow. Additional closures: Lot 425S will be closed at 6 am day of to secure ADA parking. Donors/Sponsors/VIP lots will close 24 hours prior to the event.








Players, Coaches, Staff will utilize parking closest to the perimeter of the event to minimize pedestrian and vehicular traffic in surrounding areas.

- City Metered Spaces on San Amaro
  - Will be leased from the city and blocked night prior.
- Additional closures:
  - Lot 425S will be closed at 6 am day of to secure ADA parking.




# **Orange & Greentree Game - Traffic Flow**



Traffic flow for attendees will be directed to the southeast garages and parking lots along Ponce De Leon Boulevard utilizing the main entrances of Dickinson Drive, Merrick Drive, and Stanford Drive for both egress & ingress. Parking and Transportation and contracted staff will be in all lots and garages to support traffic flow.

Main lots to be utilized will be 425S, 425N and the Ponce, Levante, and Pavia garages with additional overflow parking at Mahoney-Pearson garage.



## **Orange & Greentree Game - Transportation**




ADA Parking will be available in Lot 425S along with transportation route to Rodriguez Park. Five existing six-seater street legal golf carts, and an ADA Van will be utilized for this service for those requiring transportation. The route begins at the entrance of the Watsco Center and drops off on San Amaro into lot 601 adjacent to Rodriguez Park. The route will circle back by looping around San Amaro drive, a left onto Ponce De Leon Boulevard returning to the Lot 425S through Dickinson Drive.



Lot 42 and 43 under the Metrorail will be utilized as the Ride Share drop off points.
